Paper-Based Patient Entry

- Patient brings in CII opioid Rx. Have them fill out the [Patient Intake Form](#).
- Once completed, give the form to the pharmacist
- Process Rx as usual
- Score Patient Intake Form using [Opioid Risk Tool \(ORT\)](#).
- [Triage](#) the patient and provide interventions as necessary such as naloxone dispensing/counseling, medication take back programs and/or opioid partial fills
- Give [ND DHS brochure](#) to all patients who receive opioid prescription
- Give [ONE Rx brochure](#) to patients who are counseled on naloxone
- Fill out [Outcomes Worksheet](#) after talking to patient
- Input Patient Intake Form into [REDCap](#).
- Input Outcomes Worksheet into [REDCap](#).

Electronic Patient Entry

- Patient brings in CII opioid Rx. Have them fill out the [Online Patient Intake Form](#) either by using the pharmacies computer/iPad or a personal device using the QR code provided in your enrollment materials
- Process Rx as usual
- After patient has completed the Online Patient Intake Form, pharmacist reviews information and automatically scored ORT in REDcap
- Triage the patient and provide interventions as necessary such as naloxone dispensing/counseling, medication take back programs and/or opioid partial fills
- Give [ND DHS brochure](#) to all patients who receive opioid prescription
- Give [ONE Rx brochure](#) to patients who are counseled on naloxone
- Complete the Outcomes Worksheet responses in REDCap
