OPIOIDS

- Medications primarily used to provide pain relief
- Can lead to addiction and/or death even if taken properly
- Can be laced into other substances or made to look like candy

NALOXONE (NARCAN)

- Medication used to reverse an opioid overdose
- WILL NOT HARM if given to someone who is not experiencing an overdose
- Administered nasally

SIGNS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

- Unconscious or unable to wake up
- Breathing slows or stops
- Choking or gurgling noises
- Body goes limp
- Pale face
- Purple/blue fingernails and lips

OVERDOSE ACTION STEPS

1. Call 911
2. Administer Naloxone if available
3. Move person into recovery position
4. Stay with person until help arrives
 - You are protected under the Good Samaritan law for reporting an emergency regardless of intoxication
